
TERMS OF USE

BACKGROUND:

These Terms of Use, together with any and all other documents referred to herein, set out the terms of use under which you may use this website, www.bimhealth.co.uk ("Our Site"). Please read these Terms of Use carefully and ensure that you understand them. You accept without limitation or qualification to comply with and be bound by these Terms of Use, and any relevant provisions incorporated herein. Acceptance is deemed to occur upon your first use of Our Site. If you do not agree to comply with and be bound by these Terms of Use, your registration to the BIMhealth website will not be accepted.

1. Definitions and Interpretation

1.1 In these Terms of Use, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:

"Content"	Means any and all text, images, audio, video, scripts, code, software, databases and any other form of information capable of being stored on a computer that appears on, or forms part of, Our Site

2. Information About Us

3. Access to Our Site
