1. Partnership

2. Manufacturers

- 2.1 Upon subscription you will receive an invoice for your joining fee via email.

- 2.3 We will send you notification that your partnership is due to expire. We may contact you further should we receive no response.
- 2.4 Should we receive no response from you, your subscription will be terminated immediately and all links removed from the site.
- 2.5 Your renewal date shall be exactly one year from the date of first registration.
- 2.6 Partnership fees are paid in full and in advance.
- 2.7 Fees are non-refundable; your BIM content will remain accessible to download until your membership is properly terminated by way of non-renewal.
- 2.8 BIMhealth Ltd accepts no responsibility for the accuracy, modernity, or compliance of any content downloaded during your membership and after the membership has been terminated.

3. BIMhealth's Obligations
